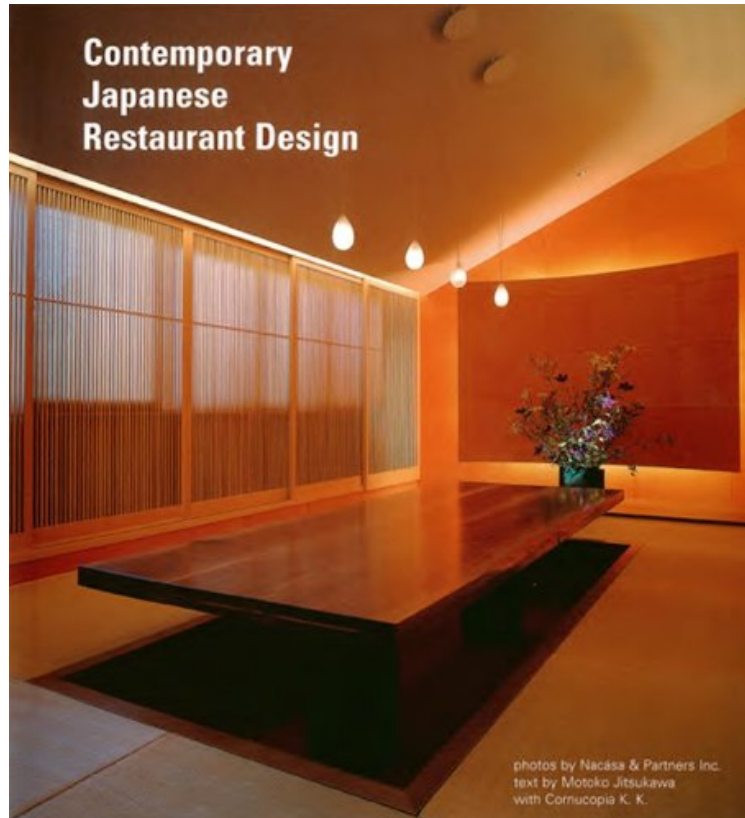

While sophisticated, urbane restaurants in Tokyo and Kyoto are featured, they vary from traditional to ultra-modern industrial in design. Floor diagrams are included. Because most of these restaurants have subdued lighting, the photographs share the same tone; but such lighting design emphasizes details of texture and shape as well as accessories. Indeed, the straight-line geometry of Japanese architecture helps provide a calming and peaceful environment.
