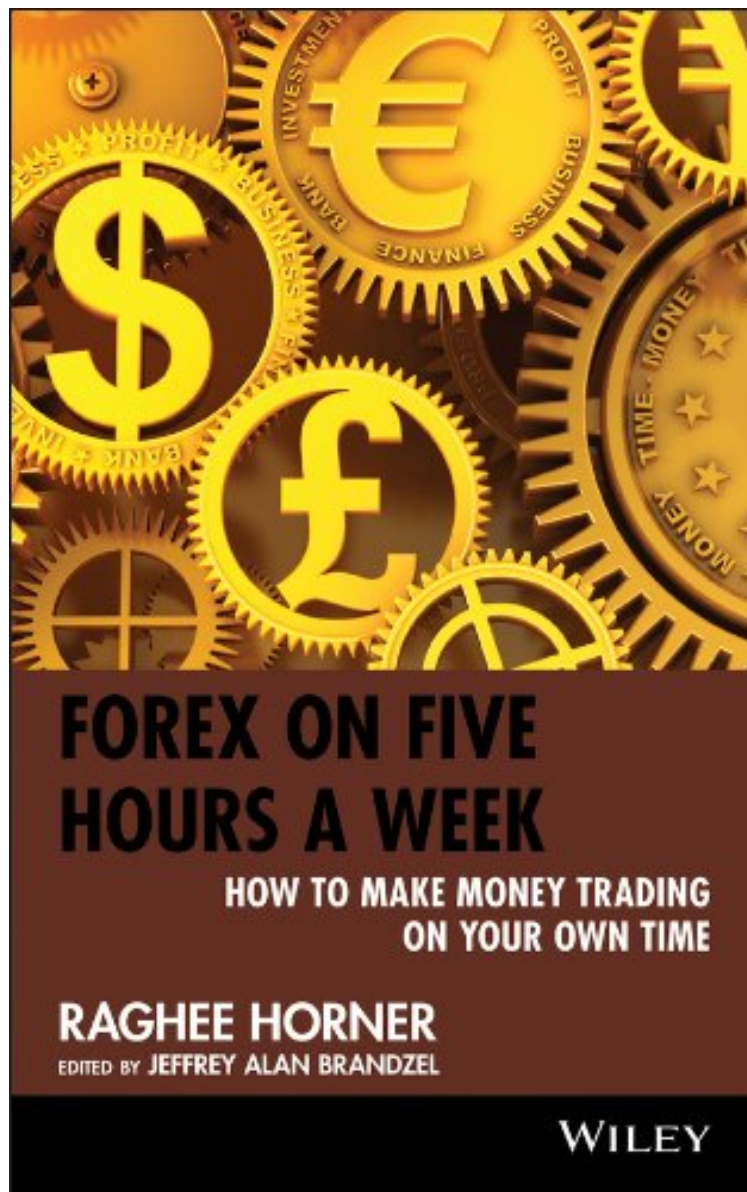

It is not a data dump that leaves you punchy, but is delivered with heart, experience and a true desire on the part of the author for you her reader/student to get at a gut level what it means to be a trader in markets. She provides what you need to know in a detailed and easily absorbable way so that you can put it into practice. By using a free demo account you can trade and test any item which the author goes over so that you also can clear up any confusion that you may have before risking real money from your account. Just because you do this does not mean that you will not have losing trades but that instead of being overwhelmed by the amount of data coming at you you will be prepared by knowing that you have to manage your emotions as well as the trade. The author goes over these topics in good detail but the time you spend in demo trade mode - which she strongly emphasises many times - will be invaluable when doing live trading. She also goes over how to set up your charts with the appropriate amount of data, what kinds of indicators she uses and how. She covers the psychology of trading, trading the news, risk and trade management all delivered with wit and her personal experience so that you end up knowing to some degree why you are doing what you do instead of flying blind. Your personal trading experience will over time clear up any lingering confusion.
